

# Reflection Questions for Backpack-worthy Artifacts

## Title: The Name of Backpack Artifact Reflection

Products that are placed in the digital Backpack should reflect your best work at that time work you are especially proud to upload into your backpack. For each backpack-worthy artifact, you will need to determine which of the Five Success Skills are relevant to that artifact and write a reflection that pertains to that artifact. The questions below serve as a guide to help you with your written reflection.

Your Reflection should demonstrate your ability to answer the two questions with CER writing structure from the section you choose to work. **Make sure you highlight the question you are answering.**

**Claim-rewrite the question**

**Evidence- Give examples of the claim**

**Reasoning-Explain How the examples demonstrate the claim**

### Prepared and Resilient Learner (select at least 2 questions)

- How does this artifact demonstrate my knowledge of content skills and standards?
- How does this artifact apply content to real-world contexts and in interdisciplinary ways?
- What were my successes and challenges with creating this artifact?
- What adjustments did I make in order to meet academic, personal and professional goals?
- What organizational and project management skills did I use in the creation of this artifact to achieve academic, personal and professional growth?

### Globally and Culturally Competent Citizen (select at least 2 questions)

- How does this artifact demonstrate my exploration of community and global issues from the perspective of those most impacted?
- What actionable solutions does this artifact demonstrate?
- How does this artifact demonstrate democratic processes to come to decisions and solutions?
- How does this artifact demonstrate compassion and empathy toward others?
- How does this artifact demonstrate a sense of belonging for others?
- How does this artifact demonstrate respect for different cultures, perspectives and/or beliefs?

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### Emerging Innovator (select at least 2 questions)

- How does this artifact demonstrate a sense of curiosity and inquiry?
- How does this artifact demonstrate asking questions to extend, challenge and clarify the thinking of myself and others?
- How does this artifact demonstrate my application of a design process (e.g. research, ideation, modeling, prototyping and testing) to create new solutions, artifacts and processes?
- How does this artifact demonstrate the use of relevant information and feedback to continually improve solutions, artifacts and processes?
- How does this artifact demonstrate my taking appropriate risks and making adjustments based on successes and failures?

### Effective Communicator (select at least 2 questions)

- How does this artifact represent appropriate conventions and evidence to convey ideas clearly in writing, verbally, digitally and/or visually?
- How does this artifact illustrate my adaptation of the message to the purpose and needs of the audience?
- How does this artifact demonstrate my use of discipline-specific writing conventions, formats and vocabulary to communicate ideas?
- How does this artifact demonstrate my use of technology effectively and responsibly?

### Effective Collaborator (select at least 2 questions)

- How does this artifact demonstrate my ability to work effectively with diverse groups to accomplish a common goal?
- How does this product demonstrate my ability to give and receive meaningful feedback?
- How does this artifact demonstrate my ability to assume responsibility for team outcomes?
- How does this product demonstrate my ability to actively listen to understand others' ideas and perspectives?
